Mercer is authorized to issue the Form I-20 for English Language Training, Degree programs, and Certificate programs.

Most of our international students transfer to four-year colleges and universities throughout the United States after completing either their English Language Training or a Degree program at MCCC.

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

- Fall semester - June 1
- Spring semester - October 1
- Summer session - March 1

The estimated yearly cost for tuition and expenses for F-1 international Students is \$19,000. (Based on 12 credits per semester. The college reserves the right to change tuition or fees at any time by action of the Board of Trustees.)

On-campus housing for MCCC international students is available at Rider University, where such students are welcomed to experience university campus life while attending Mercer County Community College.
