

Our program examines the global community with a strong focus on the study of the total human experience from an individual, social, historical, institutional and environmental perspective.

Become a citizen of the world and navigate through global cultures and individual identities to develop a broader understanding of human behaviors and interpersonal relationships among families, communities and societies.

Program Requirements:

The area of emphasis for the Online Social Sciences program is Psychology. This program requires a total of 39 core credits and 90 liberal arts credits.

In addition to the core courses, students will take 9 credits in Psychology (at least one course at 300 level), 9 credits in each of the two other concentrations; Criminal Justice, Sociology, History or Political Science, plus 18 credits in electives. A total of 30 credits must be completed at Dominican College in order to obtain a degree from our institution.

Graduates are immersed in a rich study of global cultures and develop valuable skills which include communication skills, information analysis, problem solving, and critical thinking, Knowledge of and experience with the scientific method and the application of quantitative and qualitative research methods.

Admissions

To be considered for admission to an undergraduate program, you must provide the following:

- Complete application for admission (\$35 fee)
- Submit Official transcripts from all institutions previously attended.
- Hold a grade point average of 2.0 or higher.

Transfer credits are promptly evaluated and can result in the acceptance of up to 70 credits from a two-year college and up to 90 credits from a four-year college.
