Preface

Mercer County Community College ("MCCC") and Temple University, Japan Campus ("TUJ") enter into this Affiliation Agreement ("Agreement") based on the two institutions' commitment to promoting international education and to providing their students with access to attractive educational options. More specifically, it aims to facilitate the process of MCCC students applying to study at TUJ.

Obligations of Temple University, Japan Campus

- To waive the Application Fee (currently ¥4210,000) for MCCC students who have been enrolled at MCCC within two years of submitting an application to TUI.
- To provide each MCCC student with an admission decision within three weeks two to
 four weeks of the submission of a complete application, except in limited admissions
 blackout periods.
- 3. To ensure that qualified MCCC students are considered for TUJ scholarships and other financial aid, prior to and after enrolling at TUJ.
- 4. To provide preferential access to home-stay and dormitory housing.
- To consider a MCCC-TUJ articulation agreement that indicates what MCCC credits can be counted toward Temple University degrees.
- To send have an Admissions Counselor to visit MCCC at least once a year mutually
 agreeable times, as the two institutions agree is appropriate, to provide MCCC students
 with up-to-date information on TUJ's academic programs, admissions criteria, visa issues,
 and other topics.
- 7. To designate one individual who will serve as TUJ's MCCC contact person. This individual's responsibilities will include providing MCCC with information and materials on TUJ, overseeing the management of applications from MCCC students, and otherwise

This includes raising MCCC students' awareness of TUJ through such means as posters, information sessions for interested groups/classes, individualized counseling, and other similar means.
- To designate one individual who will serve as MCCC's TUJ contact person. This individual's responsibilities will include providing information on TUJ to MCCC students and coordinating visits to MCCC by TUJ Admissions Counselors.

Either institution may terminate this Agreement with three months' advance notice. This agreement will be valid for a period two (2) years from the date of acceptance by MCCC. This agreement will be renewed automatically unless terminated or superseded by a new agreement.

- 3. To ensure that qualified MCCC students are considered for TUJ scholarships and other financial aid, prior to and after enrolling at TUJ.
- 4. To provide preferential access to home-stay and dormitory housing.
- To continue working on a MCCC-TUJ articulation agreement that indicates what MCCC credits can be counted toward Temple University degrees.
- To send an Admissions Counselor to MCCC at least once a year, as the two
 institutions agree is appropriate, to provide MCCC students with up-to-date
 information on TUJ's academic programs, admissions criteria, visa issues, and
 other topics.
- 7. To designate one individual who will serve as TUJ's MCCC contact person. This individual's responsibilities will include providing MCCC with information and materials on TUJ, overseeing the management of applications from MCCC students, and otherwise ensuring that TUJ fulfills its obligations specified in this Agreement
