## To be submitted to Transfer Services at Mercer County Community College before completing 30 transferable credits

The Guaranteed Transfer Admissions Agreement between Mercer County Community College and Rider University is designed to allow students who complete their Associate's degree at Mercer County Community College to transfer into a Bachelor's degree program at Rider University. This agreement is applicable to admission to Rider University and guarantees admission into the Elementary Education with a Second Undeclared Major in Liberal Arts & Sciences at Rider University.

By satisfying the conditions of this agreement as outlined in the Guaranteed Transfer Admission Agreement, Rider University will do the following:

- Waive the \$50 admission application fee
- Award academic scholarships to Mercer County Community College students who graduate with a 2.75 or higher G.P.A.
- Provide the Mercer County Community College student with the opportunity to meet with the Rider University representative for assistance with transferring to Rider University prior to graduating from Mercer County Community College
