

---- ADDENDUM ----
GEN ED-TO-GEN ED TRANSFER AGREEMENT
between
MERCER COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE
and
TEMPLE UNIVERSITY of the Commonwealth System of Higher Education
(Fall 2019 and Beyond)

Mercer County Community College (Mercer) and Temple University (Temple) entered into this agreement in order to facilitate the transfer of students from Mercer into Temple and to support their academic success in baccalaureate degree programs. This addendum concerns the GenEd-to-GenEd Agreement between Mercer and Temple signed January 25, 2011.

This agreement applies to students who receive an approved Associates degree from Mercer and who first enroll at Temple for or after the Fall 2019 semester. For those students, Temple agrees to accept the general education embedded in the Mercer degrees as meeting all the requirements of its undergraduate University General Education Curriculum (GenEd).

1. The following programs, as revised in 2018, qualify for GenEd-to-GenEd transfer to Temple:

- Sustainability A.S.
- Theatre A.A.

2. The following Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degrees in and only if the student is certified to Temple's Office of Undergraduate Studies by Mercer County Community College as having completed a QA/QB level mathematics course (MAT 115, MAT 116, MAT 125, MAT 149, MAT 151, MAT 200):

- Architecture A.S.
- Biology A.S.
- Business Administration (Sports Management Concentration) A.S.
- Communication A.A.
- Communication: New Media A.S.
- Computer Information Systems A.S.
- Criminal Justice A.S.
- Criminal Justice: Law Enforcement Option A.S.
- Education (K-12) A.A.

- Exercise Science A.S.
- Music A.S.
- Plant Science A.S.

Transfer students should be aware that GenEd-to-GenEd transfer relates only to University General Education requirements. All requirements of Temple's schools and colleges and major programs of study remain in force.
