Articulation Agreement Contract

**Between Moore College of Art & Design
Bachelor of Fine Arts in Graphic Design
And
Mercer County Community College
Associate of Graphic Design**

Moore College of Art & Design (Moore) and Mercer County Community College (MCCC) are entering into this agreement in order to facilitate the transfer of students who have earned the "Associate" degree in Graphic Design from MCCC. The articulation provides for entry into Moore's Graphic Design Program with junior level standing and transfer of credit under the guidelines below:

- 1 MCCC students successfully complete the courses as described in the attached document and attain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5.
- 2 MCCC students' application for admission and consideration for advanced standing in Moore's program covered under this agreement must be supported by a letter of recommendation from a faculty member of the Graphic Design department at MCCC.
- 3 MCCC Students must follow and complete the application procedures as outlined in the Moore College of Art & Design catalog.
- 4 A grade of "C" or better is required for transfer of credit in all courses. In order to transfer with advanced standing, students must complete the recommended course work at MCCC which parallels Moore programs as outlined.
- 5 Maximum allowable number of transfer credits applied from MCCC toward the BFA degree at Moore is 76.0 credits.
- 6 This contract will be mutually reviewed on a year-to-year basis to determine if adjustments should be made. Amendments to this agreement may be renegotiated when necessary for the improvement of transfer procedures. The Academic Council (or the equivalent of that council) at each institution should be notified in writing of any changes to courses or programs that might affect this agreement.
- 7 MCCC students will be considered for financial aid and housing on the same basis as other Moore students. Specifically, MCCC students would be eligible for grant and scholarship money based on their G.P.A. and portfolio on the same basis as Moore students.
