MCCC ALUMNI LIBRARY PRIVILEGES

MCCC alumni are welcome to visit the MCCC libraries. The West Windsor Campus Library features books, audiovisual resources, periodicals, reference materials, an open computer lab, electronic resources, and seating for quiet study and reflection. The James Kerney Campus Library, though smaller, has many similar resources. Alumni can use the college's electronic resources on-site, but due to vendor restrictions, off-campus/remote online access is available only to MCCC faculty, staff, and currently enrolled credit-program students. This means that off-campus access to MCCC databases, e-books, electronic subscriptions, etc. is not available to alumni. For online access to databases when off campus, alumni should contact their local public library. Alumni who are New Jersey residents or work in New Jersey can utilize the extensive database resources available from the New Jersey State Library. An MCCC Alumni card is required in order to borrow books from the MCCC library collection and to use the open computer labs located at the West Windsor and James Kerney campuses. **Cards are distributed by the MCCC Alumni Office.
