

Sea Camp

We're delighted that your child will be participating in our Marine Biology and Shore Ecology program. The following information will help you prepare for your child's adventure.

Daily Schedule:

Campers should arrive at the FA building (located behind the Security Building) no later than **7:50 a.m. for the one-week Sea Camp** program. They will be greeted by our camp instructor, Jonathan Gaffin, who will accompany them on the bus and assist with camp activities throughout the day. **PLEASE BE PROMPT; TO ALLOW SUFFICIENT TIME FOR INSTRUCTION, WE MUST LEAVE PROMPTLY!** The bus will return to the MCCC campus FA building (the same drop-off point) and students must be picked up promptly.

For 5:30 pick-up, please park in the staff lot across from Security. If the gate is not up, press the button and Security will let you in.

What to Bring Each Day:

- Backpack or duffel bag
- Swimsuit and towel
- Change of clothing
- Suntan lotion; hooded windbreaker for rainy days
- Old sneakers or water shoes for wading in the water
- Lunch with your child's name on it
- Cold beverages (individual frozen juice packs are ideal)
NO GLASS BOTTLES, PLEASE!
- Plastic storage containers & zip-lock bags
- Pencil or pen and a notebook
- \$5.00 for treats at the beach (if time allows, there may be an ice cream stop on the way home)

Other Materials and Supplies:

Tee shirt or other identifying items will be distributed on the first day. Please remind your child to bring these items each day.

Materials and equipment for individual activities will be provided by the Ocean Institute at Sandy Hook.

Medical Authorization:

There are no provisions to dispense medication for any off-campus program.
