CAMPUS KIDS — SESSION I OR II

Camp College offers your child an enriching alternative to the traditional summer day camp. Campers combine study in a variety of stimulating subject areas that emphasize intellectual growth and skills development with the fun of recreational activities. Participants choose up to six different “courses” and most courses meet 55 minutes daily for all four weeks of each session. Depending upon their departure time at the end of the camp day, campers may also participate in an optional swim period offered in the college pool, or may join other supervised activities.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All children ages 6-12 on September 30, 2010 are eligible. For one week programs up to age 16, refer to pages 18-32.

A \$25 fee will be charged for children who arrive earlier than 7:15am or remain on campus after 6pm.

WHEN IS IT?

Session I: June 21-July 15
(FOUR weeks; four days per week)
Monday-Thursday.

Session II: July 19-August 12
(FOUR weeks; four days per week)
Monday-Thursday.

AFTER-CAMP

Although classes run from 8:30am to 4:00pm each day, Monday through Thursday, campers may be picked up as late as 6pm. Children enrolled in this optional program may remain on campus after 4pm. They will join Camp College After-Camp supervised activities, including optional recreational swimming. See page 48 for details.

EARLY BIRD BEFORE- CAMP...SUPERVISED ACTIVITIES FROM 7:15-8:15AM!

For those who must drop children off prior to 8:00am, we offer an Early Bird Before-Camp. Children enrolled in this optional program may be dropped off as early as 7:15am. Experienced camp staff will supervise early arrivals. To register, use the application form on page 49.

NOTE: Children not enrolled in the Early Bird Before-Camp program may be dropped off as early as 8:00am.

WHEN DO I REGISTER?

Registration begins January 25. Register early and avoid disappointment of filled classes.

• HOW DO I REGISTER?

Mail the appropriate registration form in this brochure, and all forms from pages 45-47, and current immunization record **with your payment**, to the address indicated. Make checks payable to MCCC.

(Please complete a separate form and check for each child and include the child's name.)

Faxed forms are not accepted.

WHAT IS THE COST?

The cost is \$975 per child for each four-week session.

If you register two or more children in a family, save 5% on the second child and any additional children.

Registration will not be accepted without a completed medical form, Camper Code of Conduct, and current immunization record. See pages 45-46

The tuition fee includes all camp activities and materials unless noted otherwise in individual course descriptions.

Payment in full is due at time of registration. Deadline is two weeks prior to the camp start date. Avoid the \$10 late fee... Register Early!

There are additional charges for the Before and After-Camp care programs.

Campers may bring their own lunches or purchase meals and beverages at the College cafeteria.

REGISTER EARLY AND SAVE 50%

Fridays are truly Fun Days at Camp College. If you register for a four-week camp session by February 28, you may select (one) Friday Fun Day program and pay only ½ price.

NOTE: Some programs not eligible for discount. Discounts may not be combined.

WHAT IS THE REFUND POLICY?

A \$75 processing fee will be imposed for withdrawal in the Campus Kids four-week program.

A one-time \$10 non-refundable continuing studies summer registration fee will be applied to all students.

Refunds will be granted **only** when **written notice** of a camper's withdrawal is received by **no later than ten business days before the start of each camp session. NO REFUNDS THEREAFTER. Telephone withdrawals will not be accepted.**
