Regular Business

• Real estate project was discussed. Grace will email Camille about MLS website and Floor Plan website which can provide Camille with tools for the POS.

- Writers will spend a little bit more time expanding the project of materials.
- In developing a business plan the financials is critical but it is necessary that the POS do not overlap the Entrepreneurship POS.
- Science can be included if the projects looks at the dynamic affects in building a business, such as heating and cooling within a building.
- Camille expressed that the Programs of Study will not be able to meet the deadline dates.
- Robyn Kay requested that there must be a meeting with the writers Camille Rosenberg and Robert Carson, Maria Casale, Grace Wilson, and Jonathan Rowe. At this particular meeting it will be discussed what can be done to guarantee that the deadlines are met. The meeting setup will be discussed at another time and not at the present webinar.

Although these are just a few topics that were discussed, the finance committee and curriculum writers/presenters were engaged and made great progress.
