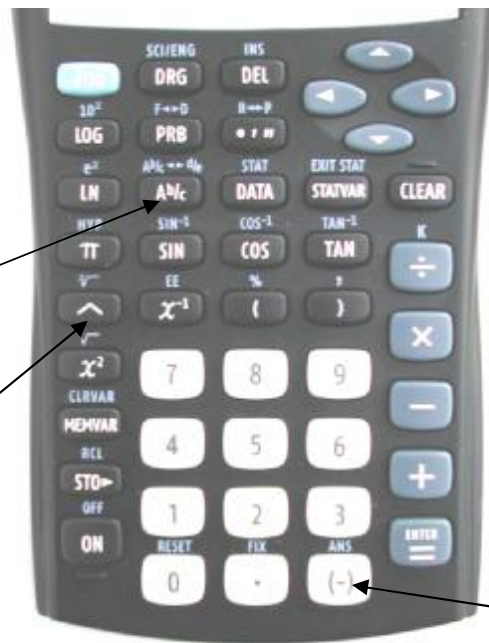


Using the Provided Calculator

The calculator you have been given is a scientific calculator similar to those used in most public schools. You may use the calculator during the exam where you think it might be useful.
