Reinstatement for Students Unsuccessful in Fall 2017

- Submit email notification of intent to return to the nursing office (nursing@mccc.edu) no later than Wednesday, January 3rd, 2018. This notification must clearly state which class and which semester you are requesting reinstatement into. Students may request reinstatement in Spring 2018 or Fall 2018. ***Reinstatement into the requested course is not guaranteed.*** Students will be placed on a space available basis.
- Schedule a meeting with your nursing faculty advisor or Director Mizerek to review the reinstatement policy. Meetings with Director Mizerek may be scheduled with Laura by calling 609-570-3391. Nursing faculty advisors are unavailable from Thursday December 21st – January 16th.
- Complete HESI remediation for any HESI exam for which you did not achieve the benchmark. This includes exams from prior semesters. A tracking sheet may be found on the nursing program website, under the policies tab.
- Attend a two hour success workshop held by the nursing program. Registration is required. Contact the nursing office to register.
 - Monday, December 11th, 2017 from 2pm-4pm
 - Wednesday, January 3rd, 2018 from 6pm-8pm
 - Saturday, January 6th, 2018 from 10am-12pm
 - Monday, January 8th, 2018 from 2p-4pm
- Write a personal success plan.
 - The first part of the success plan should identify what factors contributed to hindering your success, e.g. working 60 hours per week, inadequate study time, etc.
 - The second part of the success plan should include **specific** changes you will make to be more successful next semester. For example, do not write “I will study more” as a success strategy. Instead, write “I will dedicate Mondays and Thursdays from 1pm to 4pm for studying. On Mondays, I will read for theory class on Tuesday. On Thursdays, I will review my notes from theory class and complete the MyNursingLab work.”
 - The success plan should include at least five concrete actions you will take to be more successful in the next semester. It may be composed as a narrative or bullet point list.

- Meet with your nursing faculty advisor or Director Mizerek to complete the reinstatement process. This must be accomplished by Thursday, January 11th, 2018. Please note the nursing office will be closed from December 22nd, 2017 – January 1st, 2018.
