ADMISSIONS ASSESSMENT EXAMINATION

All students applying to the Mercer County Community College Nursing Program are required to achieve a passing score on the HESI Admission Assessment Exam *prior* to petitioning for the program. Students are limited to three (3) attempts to achieve the passing score. No student will be accepted into the Professional Phase of the Nursing Program without achieving this score. The cost of the examination is \$37.50.

**These dates are subject to change.** Students should continue to monitor the nursing website for testing updates.

**Each exam will begin promptly at the time stated above. No student will be admitted after this time. A later arrival constitutes a “no show” for the exam.** This is a timed exam. Students are allowed a maximum of **4 hours** to complete the exam. Once that time has been reached, the exam will shut off and the score achieved at that point will be the score recorded. ***Once testing has begun it cannot be stopped for any reason.*** Should a student chose to leave at any point during the exam, the score achieved at that point will be the score recorded. Any student who does not pass the exam will be required to reschedule another testing date. **Also, students who register for a given exam date and do not attend that scheduled test date must wait at least one month before being allowed to reschedule. Two or more successive “no shows” for an exam will require students to wait until the next semester to register for another exam date.** Students are required to complete **all** sections of the exam in order for their final grade to be accepted. **Students who do not complete and/or skip sections will be required to retake the exam.** Please see the full HESI Admission Exam policy under the Policies and Procedures link of the nursing website.
