The workshop is being presented by the University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA), Center for Infrastructure Assurance and Security (CIAS) and is provided at **no cost** to your agency.

This workshop is a Department of Homeland Security sponsored initiative designed to address the needs of general managers, security personnel, planning personnel, incident responders, and IT managers who oversee computer and network operations.
