

DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM BETWEEN  
MERCER COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
&  
THOMAS JEFFERSON UNIVERSITY  
SCHOOLS OF NURSING

A dual-enrollment agreement has been entered into between Mercer County Community College's (MCCC) Nursing Program and Thomas Jefferson University's (TJU) School of Nursing that would allow students graduating from MCCC's Nursing Program to also earn a BSN from Thomas Jefferson in a seamless, integrated curriculum. Students will begin the program at MCCC and then, once completed, proceed to the RN-BSN program at Thomas Jefferson.

**Admission Requirements for the RN-BSN Program**

The candidate must:

- Successfully complete attempted coursework at Mercer County Community College with a grade of "C" or better.
- Be admitted to the A.D.N. program at Mercer County Community College.
- Demonstrate English language proficiency as outline in the TJU admissions application.
- Submit a criminal background clearance and child abuse clearance to TJU prior to matriculation as outlined in the TJU admission application.
- International students or students with foreign credentials must submit an evaluation of foreign transcripts by the World Education Service (WES) or comparable agency.
- Submit to an interview.
- Meet admissions criteria as established by TJU.
- Not have a record of discipline at MCCC.

**Application Requirements to the RN-BSN Program**

- Submit an online application for admission to TJU and forward all required documents.
- Include the offer of admission letter to the A.D.N. program at MCCC.
- Provide a letter of recommendation from the student's academic advisor or other appropriate official at MCCC.
- Choose and entry term at Jefferson within two years of the anticipated date of graduation from MCCC.
