Dear Registered Nurse:

Thank you for your interest in Rutgers University MCCC campus RN to BSN completion program. Below you will find answers to frequently asked questions regarding the program.

**How long does the program take?** The length of the program depends on how many of the requisite classes you transfer in and the course load you carry. You may attend part-time or full-time. Most nurses can finish in one to two years, carrying one or two classes every semester (fall, spring, summer I and summer II).

**Can I start anytime?** Program admission is rolling. Students may begin in the fall, spring, or summer.

**How much does it cost?** Tuition is approximately \$353/credit (NJ Resident), plus fees. Most courses are three credits.

**Where are classes held?** All classes are held at the MCCC campus on Wednesdays.

**How are the classes delivered?** Some classes are held in the classroom, and some are a combination of face to face in the classroom (F2F) and online (hybrid), and some are fully online.

**How often do I have to go to Camden?** Only once.... For graduation!

**Where does advising take place?** The program coordinator is available onsite (Room FA129) for advising, most weekdays.

**What is the required GPA?** The required cumulative GPA to be considered for admission is 2.5.

**What transcripts do I need?** You will need official, sealed transcripts from your high school and every college or university you have ever attended.

## Where do I apply?

1. Go to [nursing.camden.rutgers.edu](http://nursing.camden.rutgers.edu)
2. Click on Academics
3. Click RN – BS
4. Click the link for: **Information regarding the Mercer County Community College Campus**
5. Click **APPLY NOW** and follow the directions

6. Several days after you apply, you will need to go online and check your application status. If you receive an offer of admission, you will need to **RESPOND NOW**. If you do not **RESPOND NOW**, and acknowledge acceptance, your admission process will stop.
7. After you acknowledge and accept the terms of enrollment, there will be a \$150 fee to begin your registration process.
8. Notify the RN to BSN program coordinator via email [tysha.saffold@camden.rutgers.edu](mailto:tysha.saffold@camden.rutgers.edu) your acceptance into the program, and set up a meeting for advisement to select your upcoming courses.
