



## Nursing Education Program Outcomes

### ***Program Outcome: Licensure Examination***

***Goal: 80% of program graduates will pass NCLEX on their first attempt.***

After successful completion of nursing education program, all students are eligible to take the exam to obtain state licensure as a registered professional nurse. The exam is written and administered by the National Council of State Boards of Nursing and is referred to as NCLEX (National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses). Data source: National Council of State Boards of Nursing and New Jersey Board of Nursing.

### ***Program Outcome: Program Completion***

***Goal: 30% of students who enroll in the nursing education will complete the four semesters of nursing coursework within four semesters (100% of program length).***

The nursing education program is comprised of four semesters worth of professional phase coursework. Data source: MCCC records.
