



## Nursing Education Program Outcomes

### ***Program Outcome #1: Licensure Examination***

***Goal: 80% of program graduates will pass NCLEX on their first attempt.***

After successful completion of nursing education program, all students are eligible to take the exam to obtain state licensure as a registered professional nurse. The exam is written and administered by the National Council of State Boards of Nursing and is referred to as NCLEX (National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses). Data source: National Council of State Boards of Nursing and New Jersey Board of Nursing.

***Goal: 60% of students who enroll in the nursing education will complete the four semesters of nursing coursework within six semesters.***

**Goal: 80% of graduates seeking employment will obtain work at RN within one year of graduation**

Students who have not responded to survey requests are included in the denominator, as well as students who are deferring employment to continue their education. Data source: Student self-report.
