#### **Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation(CPR) Training Requirements**

All students are required to submit proof of training in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) from either the American Red Cross or the American Heart Association. The CPR training must be geared towards the healthcare professional and include use of an automated external defibrillator (AED). The American Heart Association calls the appropriate course “Basic Life Support”. The American Red Cross calls the appropriate course “Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers.”

The CPR certification must remain current throughout the duration of the academic year (fall to spring).
