Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Training Requirements

All students are required to submit proof of training in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) from the American Heart Association. The CPR training must be geared towards the healthcare professional and include use of an automated external defibrillator (AED). The American Heart Association calls the appropriate course “Basic Life Support”.

The CPR certification must remain current throughout the duration of the semester.
