



Mercer County Community College and Wilmington College have established a Dual Admission Program that allows students enrolled in MCCC's Nursing Education Program (AS) to be conditionally admitted to a Bachelor's degree program at Wilmington College.

This guarantees eligible Mercer County Community College Associate's Degree graduates, admission into a Bachelor's Degree program with junior status at Wilmington College on the condition that they: graduate from the Nursing Program (AS) at Mercer County Community College with a minimum GPA of 2.0; complete a Dual Admissions Intent form prior to earning 30 college credits at Mercer County Community College; enroll in a Wilmington College program within one year of the Mercer County Community College graduation; do not attend another institution between the time they graduate from the Mercer County Community College and enroll at Wilmington College; and complete other regular admissions requirements as determined by Wilmington College.
