1. Please do your two modules in the ONLINE HESI review course, and take module exams. Also, under concepts, go to Health and Illness, then click on Homeostasis and Regulation. Click on fluid and electrolyte balance (this will really go into detail with renal function which is so important in NRS 235. Also, go under content area and click on adult health. There you will find intravenous therapy. Please review this material and do the NCLEX questions. Lastly, review the test preparation video. This is located under crossing the finish line.

2. Please do your two modules in the ONLINE HESI review course, and take module exams. Also, under concepts, go to Health and Illness, then click on Homeostasis and Regulation. Click on acid base. This really goes into detail about how the body systems regulate this such as the kidneys. This will prepare you for NRS 235. Also, go under content area and click on adult health. There you will find renal and urinary disorders. There are a lot of exemplars needed to know and a lot of NCLEX questions to answer.

Click on gas exchange. The respiratory system is addressed here. Pay special attention to gas exchange (pediatric patient, and diagnostic test and treatment procedures). This module will go into detail about tracheotomies, ventilated patients, cystic fibrosis, asthma, mechanical ventilation, and chest tubes. Also, click on content area and click on adult health. Go under respiratory disorders. There you will find many NCLEX questions and a lot of exemplars used in NRS 235.

5. Please do your two modules in the ONLINE HESI review course, and take module exams. Also, under concepts, go to Health and Illness, then click on oxygenation and Regulation. Then go under clotting. Pay special attention to medications, labs, medical emergencies (DIC), and adult health conditions. Plus go under the live review video and view the DIC video. It is bellow "crossing the finish line."

6. Please do your two modules in the ONLINE HESI review course, and take module exams. Also, under concepts, go to Health and Illness, then click on Homeostasis and Regulation. Go under intracranial regulation. DO all of these modules. They will all be addressed in NRS 235. Also, go under content area, and click on adult health. Go under neurological disorders. There is a ton of information there for spinal cord injuries with lots of NCLEX questions. Lastly, review the head injury video.

You will see a lot of NCLEX questions involving nutrition. This is a good summary of things you need to know and are responsible for in NRS 235. Also, please go under content area, and click on adult health. Go under GI disorders. There is great information on pancreatitis which is an exemplar in NRS 235. Plus there are great NCLEX questions.

10. Please do your two modules in the ONLINE HESI review course, and take module exams. Also, under concepts, go to Health and Illness, and then click on Homeostasis and Regulation. Click on perfusion. Do all modules but pay special attention to hemodynamics. We will start NRS 235 with SHOCK and dysrhythmias. Also, go under content area and click on adult health.
