Program Completion

Purpose: To align with nursing education and national accreditation standards in regard to program completion best practice.

Procedure:

1. All MCCC Nursing students must complete the program within six (6) semesters of the initial start of the first clinical course. This six semester program completion time frame is inclusive of any course withdrawals, leave of absence and/or course failures. If a student cannot successfully complete the program within the required six semesters, permanent dismissal from the nursing program will result.
2. Any student who is unsuccessful in two (2) nursing courses (D or lower), either the same nursing course twice or a nursing course in each of two different levels (for example NRS120 is one level and NRS220 is a second level), in the professional curriculum will be permanently dismissed from the nursing program.
