Employer Satisfaction [results reported from 2012]

(11 out of the 11 employers surveyed responded)

64% of employers responding rate our graduates a 4 or higher (on a scale of 1 to 5) in communication, critical thinking and leadership skills.

82% of employers responding rate our graduates a 4 (on a scale of 1 to 5) in professional growth and nursing interventions.

Program Outcomes [2012 surveys]

- 100% of responding graduating students stated they would recommend our program to others.(42% of graduates responding)
- 100% of responding alumni reported full time employment in nursing within 1 year of passing NCLEX. (42% graduates responding)
- 82% of 2012 graduates responded in the last year, they are attending institutions for their BSN or higher.

Graduation Rates

In 2012, 44% of students completed the nursing program within 2 years (4 semesters).

Program Completion Rates

In 2012, 80% of the students completed the nursing program within 150% of the time (6 semesters).
