Employer Satisfaction [results reported from 2013]

(employers responded regarding 39% of January 2013 graduates)

100% of employers state our graduates demonstrate satisfactory nursing practice (4 or higher on a scale of 1-5) reflecting student learning outcomes.

Program Outcomes [2013 graduate and employer surveys]

- 100% of responding graduating students stated they would recommend our program to others.(53% of graduates responding)
- 96% of responding alumni reported full time employment in nursing within 1 year of passing NCLEX. (53% graduates responding)
- 77% of January 2013 graduates responded in the last year, they are attending institutions for their BSN or higher. (53% of graduates responding)

Graduation Rates (based graduating class)

2012 73% of students completed the nursing program within 2 years (4 semesters)

2013 62% of students completed the nursing program within 2 years (4 semesters) (84 graduates)

2014 61% of students completed the nursing program within 2 years (4 semesters) (71 graduates)
