STUDENT NOTIFICATION OF UNSATISFACTORY ACADEMIC
PROGRESS

Purpose: To ensure all students are provided with the information and resources to remediate unsatisfactory academic progress in nursing courses.

Procedure:

- A. Immediately following the finalization of grades for NRS110 unit exams or midterm grades for five (5) week courses, each Course Coordinator will provide the Nursing Program Office with a list of students who have scored 78% or less on the exam.
- B. The Course Coordinator then will:
 - 1. Email all students that current exam grades are posted in the Angel course grade book.
 - 2. Email each student, via their Mercer Mail account, scoring 78% or less on the exam/midterm the Letter of Concern.
 - 3. Email each student scoring 78% or less on the exam/midterm the Suggestions to Improve Study Skills.
 - 4. Copy Nursing Program Specialist and Nursing Advisor on all emails.
- C. As stated in the Letter of Concern, the Course Coordinator will:
 - 1. Schedule a meeting with the student within 1 week of receipt of email to review the exam/midterm.
 - 2. Any student who does not attend this mandatory meeting will be unable to sit for the next scheduled exam and will receive a "0" for that exam.
- D. Nursing Program Specialist will print each email with attached forms and place hard copy in student file.
