They have made changes in the emphases for the Humanistic Studies I, II and III objectives, which has resulted in switching which of the three requirements some courses will meet. They have also reviewed their Credit Transfer Table with Mercer County Community College and have also made some minimal changes. The revisions are on the table located on the next page and they will be effective September 1, 2008. Any MCCC students already matriculated will be grandfathered and allowed to use the original requirements.
