

ADMISSION AGE REQUIREMENT

REASON FOR POLICY

To establish age and or education requirements for admission at Mercer County Community College (the “College”)

POLICY STATEMENT

- A. The College’s educational mission is focused on serving students in an adult environment.
- B. The minimum age for admission to the College is 18 years of age, unless the applicant has a high school diploma or GED or is a participant in one of the College’s Youth Programs or other programs designed for age-specific groups.
- C. Therefore, Students under the age of 18 who do not possess a high school diploma or equivalent may only be admitted to the college through one of the its Youth Programs or other age-appropriate program; or under procedures and guidelines established to admit all other underage students not possessing a high school diploma or equivalent.
- D. The President or designee shall establish procedures and guidelines for admissions regarding this specific population.
