


Kendall Anderson loves to play field hockey and lacrosse. She enjoys hanging out with friends. Kendall enjoys seeing her friends at school and taking photographs.





Ryan Sexton - Hightstown High School (grade 12)




Molly Frascella loves spending time outdoors. She also plays three varsity sports at her school and is Vice president of her class. Next year she plans on majoring in Marine Biology.






