Filling the Field: Making and Connecting with Literary Journals

Maya Marshall will discuss the logistics and impact of founding, launching, and operating literary journals. This talk and Q&A is intended to offer insight to and best practices for the many MCCC student-centered magazines. From her position as an accomplished poet and editor, Marshall will discuss the role arts magazines play in the writing landscape.

- Prof. Maya Marshall has taught at Emory University and Northwestern University. She holds fellowships from MacDowell, Cave Canem, Vermont Studio Center and elsewhere. Her writing has been published in Boston Review, Crazyhorse, Best New Poets, and elsewhere. She works as an editor for Haymarket Books, and as an assistant professor of English and creative writing at Adelphi University.
- Marshall cofounded *underbelly* magazine, the journal on the practical magic of poetic revision.
- She is the author of *All the Blood Involved in Love* and an editor at large for Haymarket Books.
