New York University Foreign Language Proficiency Test Information Bulletin

You can earn credits for languages beyond just French, German, and Spanish even if they are not offered at Mercer County Community College through the NYU Foreign Language Proficiency Program. This credit-by-exam opportunity* for fully online testing must be done through NYU. Contact them for information about which language tests are available, cost and the process for testing at sps.flpe@nyu.edu or view information online at NYU Exam (<https://www.sps.nyu.edu/homepage/academics/divisions-and-departments/center-for-applied-liberal-arts/proficiency-testing.html>).

NYU will grade your test and send you a letter indicating whether you have earned credits in your chosen language. If you request that NYU notify MCCC with your test scores, the Student Records Office will send you a note when the NYU transcript has been received.

Posting the Credits to Your Transcript at MCCC

Posting NYU foreign language credits to your MCCC transcript requires an initial \$100 processing fee. Additionally there is a charge of \$25 for every credit posted. The fee must be paid to the Bursar/Accounting Office. Then, the receipt of payment and the NYU letter of credit achievement must be submitted to the Student Records Office to the attention of Transcript Records. The maximum foreign language credits that will be granted by Mercer County Community College is 12.

*If you are a MCCC student, before purchasing a foreign language test from NYU, please meet with MCCC's Coordinator of World Languages, Prof. D'Arpa, to discuss how transferable your score will be.
