### **WHAT IS CLEP?**

The College Level Examination Program (CLEP) is a series of introductory college subject examinations that allow individuals to earn college credit for what they already know, regardless of how the knowledge was acquired. Our institution awards credit to our students for successful scores on CLEP exams.

The exams are administered on computer, and students receive instant unofficial score reports, with the exception of the 'College Composition' and 'Spanish with Writing' tests. CLEP has a STUDY GUIDE to provide information about each test and to help you prepare for your CLEP exam(s). Visit any library including our own Mercer County Community College Library and ask the Reference Librarian for the CLEP Study Guide.

### **WHAT DO I DO TO TAKE CLEP AT MERCER?**

- Go to <https://clep.collegeboard.org/> and click on "Register for an Exam."
- Register for your test(s) and pay the test fee online which generates a registration ticket.
- Print this ticket and bring it with you to your test appointment.
- CLEP tests are given at the **West Windsor Academic Support Center**. Call (609) 570-3295 or email [wwtesting@mccc.edu](mailto:wwtesting@mccc.edu) to schedule an appointment. CLEP testing is available between the hours of 10am – 2pm weekdays except on Wednesdays.

**Arrive at your CLEP appointment with the printed registration ticket and proctor fee of \$40 per test.** (The proctoring fee may be paid in our office in the form of exact amount cash. We do not have the ability to make change.)

**You will also need to present a government issued valid photo ID.**

### **MCCC Students must pay additional fees to have the credits posted to their transcripts.**

Six to eight weeks after taking the test, notice will be sent to you (using the address in your MCCC record) regarding eligibility for credits with instructions regarding posting. Hold onto this notice until ready to pay at the Student Accounts Office. **The following fees will apply: Processing Fee = \$100 Non-Refundable + Posting Credits Fee = \$25 per Credit.**
