1. Introduction to Specify Programs and Institutions

- a. This Agreement supports the transfer of students from the Liberal Arts Program at MCCC into the following degree(s)/program(s): Liberal Arts & Science: Humanities & Social Sciences AA and Liberal Arts & Sciences: Individual Studies AS at SUNY Adirondack.

2. Statement of Intent

- a. The intent of this agreement is to facilitate (associate's degree attainment) for students transferring from MCCC in the above programs. The combination of courses required to complete the Liberal Arts & Science: Humanities & Social Sciences and AA Liberal Arts & Sciences: Individual Studies AS degree, as noted, has been identified as providing the student with sufficient rigor and content to facilitate their success at SUNY Adirondack.

3. Statement of the Basic Agreement

- a. SUNY Adirondack agrees to award transfer credits from MCCC as outlined in the attached sample plan of study. These documents are hereby incorporated and made a part of this Agreement. This Agreement does not apply to students transferring with a different associate degree from MCCC or choosing a different major or program at SUNY Adirondack; such students may be evaluated for admission to SUNY Adirondack on a case-by-case basis.

4. Terms and Termination

- a. This Agreement shall commence on March 2nd, 2026, or on the date of the last signature entered in the Contract Administration section, whichever is later, and shall be in effect

for a duration of three (3) years, unless terminated earlier as provided elsewhere in this Agreement. This Agreement may be renewed by the parties' mutual written agreement for an additional three (3)- year term. Either party may terminate or suspend this Agreement for cause upon ninety (90) days' written notice; provided, however, that the parties shall discuss and reasonably attempt to resolve the issues that led to the notice of termination or suspension during the ninety (90) day period. Notwithstanding the termination of the Agreement, any student who has applied for transfer from MCCC to SUNY Adirondack prior to or during the ninety (90) day period shall be treated as if this Agreement continues to be in effect.

5. Changes in Curriculum or Program Requirements

- a. Changes made to the relevant curriculum at either MCCC or SUNY Adirondack will necessitate a review of the programs at both institutions to determine if modification of the Agreement is necessary. If deemed appropriate, a new agreement will be generated and signed. Curriculum changes by either MCCC or SUNY Adirondack must be communicated in writing no later than June 30 of any academic year by each institution's authorized agents.
- b. Each partner assumes responsibility for informing their students of curricular revisions that would impact student planning and/or degree completion. In the event graduation requirements for the associate's degree at SUNY Adirondack change within this time, the standards and practices established by SUNY Adirondack to cover such a change will apply to transfer students.

6. Admission and Matriculation

- a. This agreement does not guarantee admission to SUNY Adirondack or admission to any specific program or major at SUNY Adirondack unless otherwise stated in this agreement. Students shall apply for admission to SUNY Adirondack in accordance with the rules, policies, and procedures of SUNY Adirondack in effect at the time of application.
- b. The catalog under which the student will graduate from SUNY Adirondack will be determined by the policies and practices in place at SUNY Adirondack.
- c. As appropriate, courses transferred may fulfill SUNY Adirondack requirements. Nevertheless, students will be responsible for completing all graduation requirements of SUNY Adirondack in effect at the time of graduation in order to earn an associate's degree. Students are urged to work with an academic advisor at SUNY Adirondack prior to and after transfer in order to plan an efficient course of study for the associate's degree. This advising will be provided by the office of College Access and Student Success at SUNY Adirondack responsible for advising prospective transfer students.

7. General Provisions

- a. In carrying out the responsibilities and obligations of this Agreement, neither party shall be acting as the agent or principal of the other with regard to dealings with third parties, including students. Neither party shall have the authority to make any statements, representations, or commitments of any kind or to take any action binding the other except as provided for herein or authorized in writing by the party to be bound.
- b. This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties. No waiver, consent, modification, or change of terms of this Agreement shall bind either party unless in writing and signed by both parties.


