COLLEGE PREPARATION CLASSES

- Students who took V.I.P. college preparation classes applied to college at a **24%** higher rate than those who didn't

COLLEGE ENROLLMENT IMPACT

- Students who participated in at least one college tour were 42% more likely to enroll in postsecondary education
- 78% of First-Generation students who enrolled in VIP program also enrolled in college
- 2X more students in VIP were more likely to attend a 4-year college vs. 2-year college
