## ISRAELI IMMEDIATE RAPID DEPLOYMENT FOR TERROR AND ACTIVE SHOOTER ATTACKS

September 8, 9, & 10, 2009 0930 – 1700 Hrs. \$1195 for TWO OFFICERS/\$695 for ONE OFFICER

**Location:** Mercer County Range

Course description: This course focuses on two crucial elements: (1) to enhance and optimize the individual officer's ability to effectively survive, dominate, and neutralize a deadly threat during a violent deadly force engagement under stress; (2) to enhance and optimize the officer's ability to effectively respond to and terminate an Active Shooter attack in minimal time with minimal loss of civilian lives. This course will educate officers on the real outcomes that occur during an urban Terror oriented Active Shooter attack and provide them with the necessary mindset, knowledge, and tactics to rapidly assess, dominate, and resolve the incident. Specifically, this course will focus on Immediate Rapid Deployment strategies for Active Shooter Attacks which require immediate action with minimal availability of back-up, resources, and specialized equipment in a civilian populated environment such as a school, shopping mall, hospital, office building, or an airport. This response system is effectively applicable to an Active Shooter Attack of a Terror oriented threat or a criminal/mentally/emotionally disturbed oriented threat. Some of the topics covered in this course include; Counter-terror shooting for the handgun and submachine gun/Assault Rifle, differences between engaging a criminal and a terrorist, controlling and dominating a violent deadly force engagement, threat identification under stress, engaging an armed terrorist in a crowded environment, building and room entry and take-over tactics for one, two, three, and four man response, and active shooter response involving hostages.

Required: semiautomatic handgun with 2 magazines (min.), duty holster, submachine or long-gun with duty sling and 2 magazines (min.) Tactical oriented comfortable dress (tactical pants, t-shirt, and tactical boots), Range safety gear, knee pads (recommended)

## **Course Instructor:**

**Nir Maman:** Nir served in one of the most elite units in the Israeli Special Forces, the Central Command Counter-Terror and Hostage Rescue Unit and the Special Forces Counter-Terror and Special Operations School (C.T.S.O). During his service he held several positions including Commander of the Counter-Terror School's International Training Section where he was responsible for developing and delivering specialized Counter-Terror and Hostage Rescue training to Special Forces Units from various countries around the world that attend the Israeli Special Forces Counter-Terror and Special Operations School in preparation for high risk deployments such as Iraq and Afghanistan.

He also held the position of Lead Counter-Terror Instructor on the Counter-Terror School's Designated Hostage Rescue Take-Over Units Instruction Team, where he was responsible for training new recruits and active operational members of the Israeli Special Force's Designated Hostage Rescue Units in all areas of Counter-Terror warfare and Hostage Rescue including Hostage Rescue Operations in friendly and hostile/foreign environments, Close-Quarters-Combat, Dynamic Entry, Aircraft, Ship, Train, and Bus Interdiction, Suicide Bomber Interception, Urban Warfare, Tactical Shooting, and Krav Maga.

Nir was also assigned to the C.T.S.O. School's Chief Instruction and Research and Development Section where he was responsible for developing Counter-Terror tactics and Tactical Training Protocols that are currently taught to all Israeli Special Forces Units. His duties in this branch also included training the Counter-Terror and Special Operations School's instructors in Counter-Terror Warfare, Tactical Shooting, and Krav Maga.

Nir also held the position of Operational Team Leader on the Central Command Counter-Terror and Hostage Rescue Unit during high risk deployments which included Direct Action Operations, Arrests of high threat terrorists, and high risk entry and searches throughout the West Bank and Gaza Strip regions.

In April 2009 Nir was awarded the Israeli Defense Force Ground Forces Command Soldier of the Year Award of Excellence for his service in developing Counter-Terror tactics for the Israeli Special Forces and for excellent service in commanding the Counter-Terror School's International Training Section.

Nir holds a Top Secret Security Clearance from the Israeli Ministry of Defense and a Secret Level Clearance from the Canadian Security and Intelligence Service. Nir is also a certified Police Tactical Operations and Use of Force Instructor through the Atlantic Police Academy in Prince Edward Island Canada where he was a sworn Police Constable working as a Tactical and Use of Force Instructor.

Nir has delivered Active Shooter Response and Counter-Terror training to many Law Enforcement and Military units across North America including Tactical/SWAT units, and Local, State, and Federal Agencies.
