**Water Safety for Police Officers and Park Rangers**

This 1-day course teaches the hazards of moving water, basic self-protection and awareness of water rescue techniques. Morning class will be lectures, demonstrations and videos of rescues gone wrong and the afternoon will be a basic practical exercise using throw ropes on dry land. This course is not designed to make the officer a swift-water rescue technician. Statistics show that one in four drowning events in a water rescue situation, the rescuer is a first responder. The course is designed to show what to do and what not to do in water rescue situations. Officers attending should bring all safety equipment carried in their patrol vehicle for evaluation and practice. **Class size is limited to 20.**
