**ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA and RANK SCORING**

- You must be a MCCC student with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA documented on your MCCC transcript.
- Complete BIO103, BIO104, PHY109, and MAT 125 with a grade of “C+” or higher. One or more of the mathematics and/or science courses may be in progress in the semester of petition submission (spring). Science and mathematics courses expire after ten years and must be current through the semester commencing Radiography courses (fall).
- Complete radiography general education courses with a grade of “C” or higher. One or more of the general education courses may be in progress or incomplete in the semester you submit the radiography application (spring).
- All mathematics, science, and general education courses that are earned within two
- (2) attempts will be ranked higher for the professional phase of the radiography program.
- You must retain active status at MCCC.
