A. Role

The College Governance Council (CGC) provides a college-wide forum for discussion and debate of college initiatives, practices, and procedures having campus-wide impact across the various constituencies of the college. It is responsible for guiding and supporting the college's strategic planning efforts, and communicating information on the decisions and issues that are of interest to the entire college community. The scope of work of the CGC includes, but is not limited to:

Proposed Changes:

A. Role

The College Governance Council (CGC) provides a college-wide forum governing body of elected representatives for discussion, and debate and approval of recommendations of college initiatives, practices, and procedures having campus-wide impact across the various constituencies of the college. It is responsible for guiding and supporting the college's strategic planning efforts and communicating information on the decisions and issues that are of interest to the entire college community; the group is a conduit for the concerns of the community to the Executive Team.

From 2009 document:

3. A parliamentarian shall be appointed by the chair of the CGC for a term of one year, renewable for one year. The parliamentarian shall be selected based on knowledge of parliamentary procedure. The parliamentarian will serve as an *ex-officio* member of the CGC. Duties of the Parliamentarian include applying the rules contained in Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, at CGC meetings when necessary.

Proposed Changes:

A The Vice Chair shall be responsible for maintaining an orderly meeting following a basic version of Robert's Rules. act as parliamentarian shall be appointed by the chair of the CGC for a term of one year, renewable for one year. The parliamentarian shall be selected based on knowledge of parliamentary procedure. The parliamentarian will serve as an *ex officio* member of the CGC. Duties of the Parliamentarian include applying the rules contained in *Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised*, at CGC meetings when necessary.
