









## How to Roll Back to a previous version of Java

Some components of the latest version of ANGEL are not fully compatible with the most recent update to the Java. In order to make your computer function properly within the ANGEL environment, it may be necessary to uninstall the latest Java update from your computer. Here's how to do it:

<b>Step 1:</b>	<p>Prior to doing anything, you will need to close any open programs on your computer.</p> <p>In order to uninstall Java, you will need to go to “Add/Remove Programs”. To do this, go to the Control Panel. To get to the control panel, click on the  Button. When the menu pops up, click on  <b>Control Panel</b>.</p>	
<b>Step 2:</b>	<p>Once the Control Panel loads, click on the Add or Remove Programs link. This will load up a list of all the programs that are installed on your computer. <i>(NOTE: Depending on the speed of your computer, this could take a while to load)</i></p>	 Add or Remove Programs
<b>Step 3:</b>	<p>Scroll through the list until you see Java (TM) 6 Update 11. Click on the entry to expand it. <b>Step 4:</b>	<p>To remove Java 6 Update 11, click on the  button. You’ll see a prompt asking if you’re sure you want to do this.</p> <div>  to confirm the removal of Java 6 Update 11.</div>	
<b>Step 5:</b>	<p>You’ll see a series of windows popping up, but you don’t need to do anything more. Your computer will do the rest!</p>
